| Anatomy       | A presentation of basic anatomy for the dancer & dance teacher.  |
| Pedagogy      | A look at various aspects to consider when teaching a dance class (including planning classes, teaching styles, classroom management, and evaluation). |

Both these courses will be taught by Examiners from both National and Ontario Branch.

**TEACHER DEVELOPMENT COURSE**  
**SATURDAY, August 11th and Sunday, August 12th**  
**2018**

**Cost per session \$150/ 4 classes**

**This course is open to all CDTA members. It is recommended for any Affiliates preparing for an Associate examination.**

**The purpose of this course is to assist and educate teachers as they prepare or continue to teach dance as a career.**

**This course consists of short seminars on the following:**

- 1) MUSIC - development of musical notation, understanding and writing basic rhythms and becoming familiar with musical terms used in dance.**
- 2) HISTORY - Brief history of various styles of dance in North America (Tap, Jazz, Ballet and Modern)**
- 3) ANATOMY - Knowledge of Anatomy for the Dancer - also addresses common technical problems with suggested exercises to help students strengthen and overcome them.**
- 4) PEDAGOGY - Pedagogy includes the "how to" of planning classes, classroom management, teaching styles and self-evaluation for newer teachers and those helping train young teachers.**

**This is an introductory course. Future Teacher Development courses will be longer and will include, for example the "how to's" for teaching steps and movements specific to a genre as well as address the semantics of both owning and running a business or working as an employee.**
