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### **TAP ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP EXAMINATION (1 ¼ HOURS)**

#### **PART A.**

Class of students, (C.D.T.A. Grade III level) to be taught by candidate. No longer than 45 minutes (3/4 hr.) \*The candidate will supply between 4 and 6 of their own students. Music for your class is to be prepared and brought with you including rhythm section.

A class plan and biography written by the candidate (in duplicate) is to be brought to the examination and presented to the Examiners. The plan should include a complete outline of your class including the counts for all exercises and combinations.

#### **PART B**

Candidate alone (after the students leave) 30 minutes.

1. Knowledge of C.D.T.A. (Ontario Branch) student syllabus including terminology, history and all combinations, up to and including the C.D.T.A. Grade III along with questions on theory, teaching methods, anatomy, music, and build-ups from basic work to advanced work (i.e. pick ups).
2. Rhythms. \*\*Candidates supply their own music.

Explain the rhythms, time signatures, and prepare and execute 5 short combinations, to your own music (8 bars) appropriate for the following rhythms (not necessarily in the following order):

Waltz                      March                      Soft Shoe                      Bright 4/4                      Beguine

3. Routine: Tap routine of the candidates OWN choreography to be executed to music.

A minimum of 32 bars.

\*Note: If you are unable to bring your own students, the C.D.T.A. will supply students given 6 weeks notice.
